FIRST AID FACILITIES:-

DEFIBRILLATOR & Stretcher	NO
FIRST AID ROOM	A room can be used in the Football Centre which is to the left of the grass pitches along a path past the artificial pitch, the centre is on your right hand side. Duty manager will guide you from there.

ACCESS ROUTES:-

FOR AMBULANCE	When calling for an ambulance instruct them to turn into Rushcliffe School but don't go into the car park, follow the road past the bus stop and turn left at the Sixth form building. The duty manager will then raise the barrier PLEASE INFORM HIM after the ambulance has been called. He is located in the Football Centre, it is usually Marlon. The ambulance can then drive up to the foot of the grass pitches. Centre number is 0800 228 9642
FIRST AID ROOM TO AMBULANCE	As above, it can only go to the foot of the grass pitches.
PITCHES TO AMBULANCE	As above, it is a short walk up an incline to the pitches.

Directions to the Hospital	Leaving the Car park, turn left onto Boundary road turning left. At the end turn left onto A60 Loughborough Road. At the Nottingham Knight roundabout take 3rd exit onto A52 Clifton Boulevard and continue for approximately 3 miles. Once over the flyover on the A52 take the sliproad left (North Road) signpost QMC. Follow hospital signs for parking and A&E department

Directions to the Hospital:	Leave car park onto Boundary Road, turn right. At the traffic lights turn left onto A606 Melton Road, follow the A606 until the second set of traffic lights. Take the third exit onto A60 Loughborough Road continue onto the A60 London Road, over Trent Bridge until you reach the BBC roundabout. Take the 4th exit so you are returning back onto London Road. Take the first left City Link into the NHS walk-in centre car park.
