FOR AMBULANCE	Assign someone to inform the caretaker once ambulance has been called or call 07970 272038. There may not always be a caretaker on duty, however they should be informed. Someone to stand at the entrance of West Park to direct the ambulance in

FIRST AID ROOM TO AMBULANCE	Concrete path leading from the Pavilion which is sloped to the car park
PITCHES TO AMBULANCE	There is a gate in the railings near the Sir Julien Cahn Pavilion that can be unlocked by the caretaker so that the ambulance can drive onto the pitches

Direction to the Hospital	Turn left onto the A60 Loughborough Road. At the traffic lights turn left on Wilford Lane, continuing until you reach the Clifton flyover. Take the first exit onto the sliproad towards Derby/The North/Mansfield/A52. Merge onto A52/Clifton Boulevard and continue for approximately 1.4 miles. Once over the flyover on the A52 take the sliproad left (North Road) signpost QMC. Follow hospital signs for parking and A&E department

Direction to the Walk In Centre	Turn left onto the A60 Loughborough Road, through the traffic lights and continue onto the A60 London Road, over Trent Bridge until you reach the BBC roundabout. Take the 4th exit so you are returning back onto London Road. Take the first left City Link into the NHS walkin centre car park.
