Direction to the Hospital	Leave Regatta Way towards A6011/Radcliffe Road, Turn left on onto Radcliffe Road. At the roundabout, take 2nd exit onto A52/Gamston Lings Bar Road, Pass through 2 roundabouts remaining on the A52. Once over the flyover on the A52 take the sliproad left (North Road) signpost QMC. Follow hospital signs for parking and A&E department

Direction to the Walk In Centre	Leave Regatta Way towards A6011/Radcliffe Road, bear left onto A6520 Radcliffe Road. Then turn right onto the A60 London Road over Trent Bridge and continue on this road until you reach the BBC roundabout. Take the 4th exit so you are returning back onto London Road. Take the first left City Link into the NHS walk-in centre car park.
